CHESHAM Bois batsmen Phil Ashwell (165) and Craig Ringsell 87 were in record-breaking form this Saturday as Bois beat Frieth by 71 runs in Division One of the Kookaburra Mid Bucks League.

Ashwell became the highest run-scorer in Chesham Bois history, passing Alan Lathwell's record of 12,650, with his second hundred in consecutive weeks.

It smashed a 19-year-old record, with Lathwell again being the unfortunate man removed from the record-book.

The stand was only broken when a tiring Ringsell lobbed an easy catch back to the bowler.

Bois declared on 261-2 from 35 overs as Ashwell was out from the last ball of the innings.

In response, Ross Kemp struck early for Bois as he

removed Cannor for a second-ball nought with a good catch from Zahid.

However, Bois then struggled to take more wickets until Zahid bowled Waller for nine.

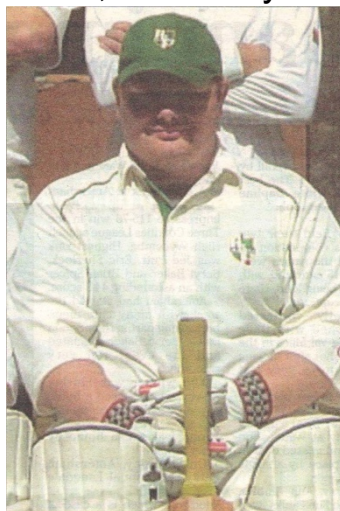
It was the introduction of Mike Adams that turned the game as his excellent spell of bowling ripped through the Frieth middle order.

Only Berry (92 n.o.) offered resistance as Adams claimed figures of 6-36.

Horne and Berry managed a last-wicket partnership of 83 as they both smashed the Bois bowling around.

Frieth were finally finished off for 190 by man of the moment Ashwell who dismissed Horne with help from a brilliant catch in the deep by Kemp.
